The lines represent key relationships and the arrows represent the tables with the primary keys.

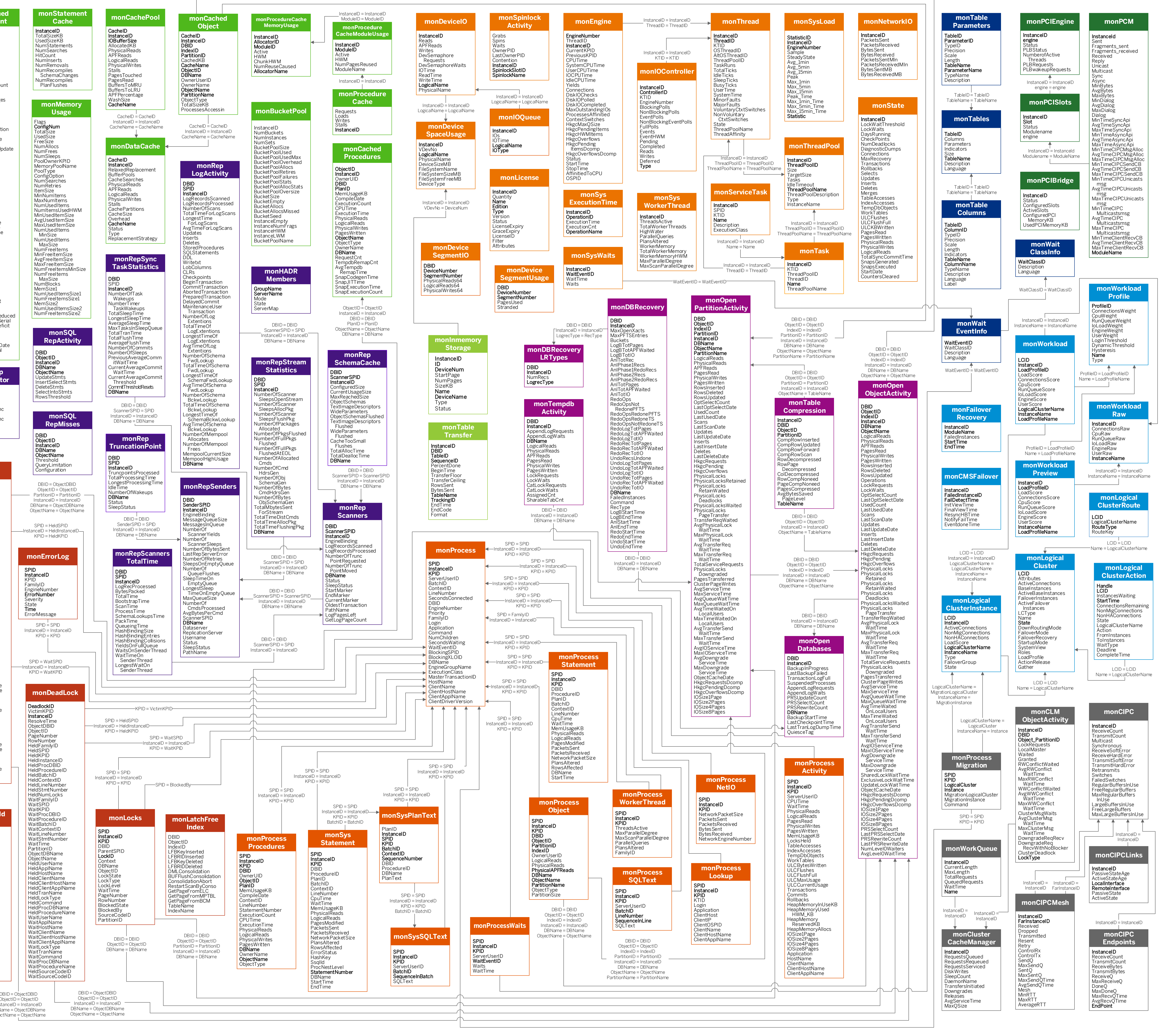
The column names in the relationships appear on the lines. The tables include the table names, as well as the column names and their datatypes.
